

Coastal areas are vulnerable to climate change and environment change, mainly because of rising sea level and wave heights – accelerated erosion. Especially comunities loclaised along coast: residence, communication, economic activities, social activities, tourism











#### Socio economical and ledislation ideas.... outline

#### Actions needed for these comunities include:

- 1. Spatial planning as tool for sustainable development and threats warning
- 2.Ensuring that new development and infrastructure planning takes into account climate change to avoid future risks
- 3.Increasing capacity (land, budget) to prepare for climate risks and recover from specific endengering events (storm surges, fires, algaes or other poisoning contaminants)
- 4. More adaptive local nad national institutions, and higher budget for their tasks,
- 5. Better transboundary cooperation between countries on local administrative level




